

## OHA District Service Award

***This is an award that recognizes an individual, Society or organization for effective, long service in the cause of horticulture. It is the highest award that may be given by a District.***

This award is an engraved wooden plaque provided by the Ontario Horticultural Association. One nomination may be made each year by each Society within a District to the District Director in a letter giving full details of the nominee's qualifications. From these nominations, the District Executive may select one award winner per year. The name of the recipient and the date of presentation are to be submitted to the Association Secretary by the District Director at least four months before the award is to be presented. The Association Secretary maintains a listing of recipients. The criteria to be followed in the selection of a candidate are:

1. An individual who has given effective, long service to a Society or District, preferably a minimum of fifteen years
2. An individual who has given extensive service to horticulture, exclusive of Horticultural Societies
3. A Society or organization which has undertaken and completed a special project in horticulture or for a special accomplishment.
